5. I am dead certain that he is lying. (Dead is an adverb. It modifies the adjective 'certain'.)

6. She is pretty old. (Pretty is an adverb. It modifies the adjective old.)

7. Rani is a pretty girl. (Pretty is an adjective. It modifies the noun girl.)

8. Go straight and then turn left. (Straight is an adverb. It modifies the verb go.)
