We often use the past tense form to express a wish. This is quite common after expressions like I wish, I'd rather, If only, As if, Suppose, and It's time/high time.
Study the examples given below.
I wish I was taller. (NOT I wish I am taller.)
It's time you started looking for a job.
She behaved as if she had been a total stranger.
